

BEEF COW/CALF MANAGEMENT - ASSOC/ASSIST PROFESSOR

The Department of Animal Science, University of Minnesota invites applications for a tenure-track, 9-month faculty position (Assistant/Associate Professor) in beef cow/calf management. The appointment responsibilities will be research (60%) and extension (40%).
