

Boarding Policies at the OSU Horse Center

September, 2009

The OSU Horse Center has limited partial care boarding for OSU students and Animal Science Faculty involved in our Equine Science Program. Boarding will no longer be available to community members or non-students. OSU students must provide a written application, riding demo video, and letter of recommendation. Selection of students is announced in late summer for fall term boarding or as stalls become available during the academic year.

Selection criteria include past and current involvement in the equine program at OSU, student's demonstrating outstanding horsemanship and leadership, letter of recommendation, boarding history at the OSU Horse Center, and preference for upperclassman standing (see Criteria for Student Boarding at website below). Students are required to read and follow OSU Horse Rules, Terms of the Boarding Agreement, and Code of Conduct.
